As a volunteer involved in the Presbytery of the Cascades Camp Program, I agree to abide by the following code of volunteer conduct:

As a volunteer, **I will:**

- Guard the health, safety and welfare of children and youth in my care at all times.
- Treat each child, youth and person at camp with respect, patience, integrity, courtesy and consideration.
- Avoid situations where I am alone with a child or youth, or member of the opposite sex during camp.
- Report suspected abuse or neglect to the camp dean.
- Communicate any problems and special circumstances to the head counselor or camp dean.
- Follow all the rules and guidelines of the camp and camp site.
- Dress appropriately for camp activities.

As a volunteer, **I will not:**

- Behave in a way that frightens or intimidates children, youth or any person.
- Humiliate, ridicule, threaten or degrade any person
- Touch a child, youth or any person in a sexual or inappropriate manner.
- Sexually harass any person, such as by making sexually explicit statements, etc.
- Use, possess or be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs at any time while volunteering.
- Use or possess tobacco products while volunteering.

As a volunteer I promise to strictly follow the rules and guidelines of the Code of Conduct. I understand that failure to do so will result in being removed from my volunteer responsibilities.
